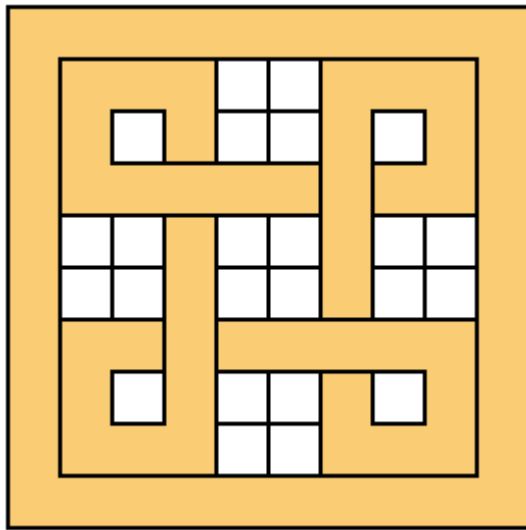


# WACKY WEAVE CELTIC KNOTS

## ABBREVIATIONS

AxB – alternate X number of stitches starting with back, for example: A5B = B, F, B, F, B

AxF – alternate X number of stitches starting with front, for example: A5F = F, B, F, B, F

B – dcib, ch1

CC – contrast colour

ch – chain

dc – double crochet

dcib – double crochet in back

dcif – double crochet in front

F – dcif, ch1

hdc – half double crochet

MC – main colour

sc – single crochet

sk – skip

## STITCH PATTERN

- Row 1A: with MC and a 3.5mm hook, ch24, dc1 in the 6th ch from the hook, (ch1, sk1, dc1) 10 times, you should have 10 windows in the width.
- Row 1B: with CC and a 3.5mm hook, ch22, lay the CC chain, across the MC trellis, take care to have your MC loop and working yarn on the left, and the CC loop and



working yarn, on the right, start in the 6th ch from the hook, in the 2<sup>nd</sup> MC window: 8B, dcif in the last ch, turn.

- Row 2A: with CC to the back, ch4, B, 2F, 3B, 2F, B, dc outside in the last window, do not turn.
- Row 2B: ch4, A3B, 2F, A3B, dcib in the last window, turn.
- Row 3A: with CC to the front, ch4, 9F, dc outside in the last window, do not turn.
- Row 3B: ch4, F, 4B, A3F, dcif in the last window, turn.
- Row 4A: with CC to the back, ch4, B, F, 2B, 4F, B, dc outside in the last window, do not turn.
- Row 4B: ch4, 2F, B, 5F, dcib in the last window, turn.
- Row 5A: with CC to the front, ch4, 9F, dc outside in the last window, do not turn.
- Row 5B: ch4, (2B, F) twice, 2B, dcif in the last window, turn.
- Row 6A: with CC to the back, ch4, 9B, dc outside in the last window, do not turn.
- Row 6B: ch4, 5F, B, 2F, dcib in the last window, turn.
- Row 7A: with CC to the front, ch4, F, B, 2F, 4B, F, dc outside in the last window, do not turn.
- Row 7B: ch4, A3F, 4B, F, dcif in the last window, turn.
- Row 8A: with CC to the back, ch4, 9B, dc outside in the last window, do not turn.
- Row 8B: ch4, A3B, 2F, A3B, dcib in the last window, turn.
- Row 9A: with CC to the front, ch4, F, 2B, 3F, 2B, F, dc outside in the last window, do not turn.
- Row 9B: ch4, 8B, dcif in the last window, end off CC, turn.
- Row 10A: ch4, 9F, dc outside in the last window, end off MC.

## BORDER

### CC-BORDER

Switch to a 3mm hook. Use your CC yarn. Crochet only around the CC frame.

Start with a standing single crochet in any window. Crochet 2 single crochets in every side window and 5 single crochets in every corner window. Close the round with an invisible join.

### MC-BORDER

Continue with the 3mm hook. Use your MC yarn. Crochet into each CC stitch, but catch the MC chain behind it, thus joining the two pieces together.



Start with a standing half double crochet in the middle stitch of the 5 CC corner stitches – remember to catch the corner MC chain behind (crochet over it), hdc2 in the same stitch, hdc1 in the next st, using the same corner space, [(hdc1 in the next CC stitch and the next MC window, hdc1 in the next CC stitch and the same MC window) x8 times, hdc1 in the next CC stitch and the corner window, hdc3 in the next CC stitch in the same corner window, hdc1 in the next CC stitch in the same corner window] x3 times, [(hdc1 in the next CC stitch and the next MC window, hdc1 in the next CC stitch and the same MC window) x8 times, hdc1 in the next CC stitch and the corner window, close the round with an invisible join and weave away the tails.
